Nixon to secure the payment of Two Thousand and 700 Dollars on the following described real estate in Tulsa Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma)

Lots numbered seven (7) and eight (8) in Block number five (5) in the Town of North Tulsa, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma) according to the recorded survey and plat thereon, and recorded in Volume 3 of mortgages on Page 323 at Tulsa Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma) on the 26th day of July 1907 and also recorded in Volume 3 of mortgages on Page 364 at Tulsa Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma) on the 12th day of September, 1907, is redeemed, paid off, satisfied and discharged in full.
