

Deed of Release.

Whereas, Allen S. Rogers and Family Rogers, his wife & their deed of mortgage dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1906 and recorded in the Recorder's Office in and for Western District, Indian Territory in D.C. 17 as Page 20, conveyed to W.M. Stigall, the property in said deed described, to-wit: to W.M. Stigall the payment of one hundred and ten and  $\frac{10}{100}$  dollars, so evidenced by a certain note as in said deed fully described and set forth. And whereas, the said Allen S. Rogers lawfully paid and satisfied said note, and is justly and legally entitled to a full release of the said deed of mortgage.

Now, therefore, I, W.M. Stigall do hereby receive, release and quit claim unto the said Allen S. Rogers and his heirs, the property in said deed of mortgage, described as follows, to-wit: The northeast quarter  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the northwest quarter  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section thirty-three (33) townships twenty (20) of range fourteen (14) east of the Western District, Indian Territory. To have and to hold the same, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, free, clear and discharged from the encumbrances of said deed of mortgage.
