 hereby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said
 R. B. McKenney & Mattie Belle McKenney, his wife and
 unto their heirs and assigns forever the following
 described real estate lying in the Tulsa County, Okla-
 homa, formerly Western District of the Indian Territory
 to-wit: Lot Four (4) in Block Fifteen (15) in the City
 of Tulsa according to the amended plat of said
 block as authorized by Ordinance No 119 of the City
 of Tulsa and recorded in the Recorder's Office in
 the Eighth Recording District.

The deed being made to release the lien of a
 certain mortgage dated March 3rd, 1906 and recorded
 March 5th 1906 at 9 A.M. in Book V at Page 520 of the
 records of Mortgages at Sapulpa Ind. Terr.

This deed of release is made by the undersigned
 officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of
 the authority conferred upon him in Article VII of the
 Bylaws of said Company, as follows:

"The Secretary shall have equal power with the Pres-
