

Assignment of Mortgage.

Whereas, on the 5th day of May 1906, Mary Bradman (widow) did execute a note and mortgage on all of lot number two (2) block nine (9), original town of Tucker, Indian Territory, to Eva E. Lyman of Richmond, Indiana, and, whereas the said Eva E. Lyman is deceased, and whereas the said Lyman has been properly and legally appointed as executor of the estate of the said Eva E. Lyman, deceased, as executor of the assignment. Now all men by these presents: That, I, Sime L. Stryker, the duly appointed executor of the estate of Eva E. Lyman, deceased, the mortgage named in a certain mortgage, covering all of lot number two (2), block nine (9), original town of Tucker, Indian Territory, given by Mary Bradman (widow) to the said Eva E. Lyman, deceased, dated the 5th day of May 1906, recorded May 14th, 1906, in book 50" page 241 in the office of the United States Clerk and Ex-officio Recorder of Oklahoma, Indian Territory, the consideration of one (\$100) dollar paid by C. W. Coggeshall. The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby assign, transfer, convey and acknowledge the said mortgage debt, the said C. W. Coggeshall the said mortgage and the real estate thereby conveyed and the mortgage and the same to have and to hold, the same to the said C. W. Coggeshall, his heirs and assigns, to him and his heirs and assigns forever, subject, nevertheless, to the conditions therein contained and to redemption according to law.
