

Deed Of Release.

Know all men By These Presents:

That J. M. Cline, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to me paid by J. W. Dillard do hereby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said J. W. Dillard, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south one half of Lot Three (3), except that portion held by the M. K. & T. Railroad in the Town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the official survey.

This deed being to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated October 26th 1905 and recorded October 30, 1905 in Book L at Page 467 of the records of the eighth recording district of the Indian Territory, by J. W. Dillard, conveying said real estate to J. M. Cline to secure payment of one certain note, therein named, the same having been fully paid.
