

Deed Of Release

Know all Men By These Presents:

That J. G. McGannon for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to me paid by Ella Gowers, do hereby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said Ella Gowers and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following described real estate lying in the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, now County of Tulsa, Okla.: The northerly 50 feet of Lot Five block 159, more particularly described as beginning at the north west corner of said Lot 5, running thence easterly parallel with south line of west 6th street 140 feet to an alley, thence southerly parallel with east line of South Elwood Ave. 50 feet, thence westerly 140 feet to east line of South Elwood Ave. thence northerly parallel with Elwood Ave. 50 feet to place of beginning, all in City of Tulsa, Okla. according to recorded plat thereof.

This deed being to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage, dated Sept. 26, 1907, and recorded Sept 26, 1907 in Book 21 at Page 264 of the records of the twenty eighth recording district of the Indian Territory, by Ella Gowers & husband conveying said real estate to J. G. McGannon to secure payment of one certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid. Witness my hand this 12th day of May, 1908.
