

The undesignated track above a certain Road of Quail
 dated the 27th day of March, 1906, made by Earl Quail.
 A large mass in garnet & orthoclase, double for
 the 27th day, recorded in the records of the eighth
 Recording District of the Indian Territory, in Book 8.
 at Page 34, and which said mass was fourteen or
 eight to the undesignated, in so far as the same
 apply. The land hereafter described, and no other
 and so necessary the premises hereafter described
 to the greater of said Road of Quail, for four and
 assigned, said premises so released being described
 as follows:
 A tract, land situated in the northeast quarter
 of section (3), Township (3), Range (19), north, in the
 Creek Nation, in what was formerly the Indian
 Territory, now in State of Oklahoma.
 Township, north in Range (3), in the State of Okla.
 Township, north in Range (3), Township (3), Range (19), north, in the
 beginning at the northeast corner of the south
 west quarter of section (3), Township (3), Range (19), north
 approximately, thence west along the east and west
 center line of section (3), a distance of four hundred
 feet and right (450) feet, thence in a southeasterly di-
 rection and making an angle of 85 degrees and 15 min-
 utes with the east described course, a distance of thirteen
 hundred and twenty (1320) feet, more or less, to the
 south line of the northeast quarter of south west
 quarter of said section (3); thence west along the
 south line of the northeast quarter of south west
 quarter of said section (3), a distance of one hundred and
 five (105) feet, more or less, thence north east and making
 an angle of 85 degrees and 15 minutes with east

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
