

Contract.

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This contract made and entered into this 20th day of May 1908, by and between H. O. Cavert of Independence Kansas, and H. C. Calhoun and Mattie M. Calhoun his wife, parties of the first part, and George D. Blakey, party of second part, Witnesseth:

That whereas the parties hereto have built a brick wall, two stories in height, thirteen inches in width and one hundred feet deep on the north thirteen inches of lot numbered seventeen in block numbered eighty nine in Tulsa, Oklahoma, allowing for the deviation of the townsite from the true meridian.

Now, therefore the said wall so erected is declared to be a party wall, occupying a legal status as such with mutual privileges to the parties hereto, and with the usual right of making further extensions at the expense of the party so desiring and making such extensions.

This contract shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective heirs, assigns and representatives and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, assigns and representatives.
