 To Loren Conway & wife Presents that the Union
 Trust Company (an Indian
 Territory corporation) of Tulsa Oklahoma for
 and in consideration of the sum of Five
 Hundred Thirty ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars to it paid by
 Loren Conway has hereby grant sell
 quit claim and release unto the said Loren
 Conway and I. da C. Conway his wife and
 unto their heirs and assigns forever the
 following described real estate lying in
 the Tulsa County Oklahoma, formerly section
 District of the Indian Territory to wit:-

Part of Lot five (5) in Block one hundred
 sixty-three (163) in town of Tulsa de-
 scribed as that part of Lot five (5) having
 a frontage of twenty-five (25) feet on
 Main Street and a depth of one hundred forty
 (140) feet to an alley and adjoining Lot six (6)
 with a uniform width of twenty five (25)
 feet according to the official plat thereof.

This deed being made to release the
 lien of a certain mortgage dated January
 21st 1907, and recorded January 31st 1907 at
 2⁴⁰ p.m.; in Book 11, at page 12 of the records
 of mortgages at Tulsa Ind Ter.

This deed of release is made by the
 undersigned officer of the Union Trust
