It appearing to the Court at a hearing on the 6th day of June 1907 that in the — day of May, 1908, Emily J. M. Connelley, executrix, in the above entitled cause, filed her petition in this Court praying for the confirmation of the Court herein decided, and, it further appearing to the Court that in the said day of May, 1908, the Court made an order setting the 6th day of June, 1908, for the hearing of said petition, and in said order require the petitioner to appear to the said hearing for a point of this type previous to the said 6th day of June, 1908, and it further appearing to the Court that under the leave of the wife of the above named deceased, the said wife having been admitted to probate in this Court on the 10th day of December, 1907, the executrix, Emily M. Connelley, the petitioner, appeared, was authorized and empowered to act and defend herself and all of the interests said, accordingly as to her occurred fit and proper, and, it further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said order the said executrix, Emily J.
