

Deed of Release

Know all men by these presents,
that I, D. F. Colley, for and in consideration of the sum of
One dollar, to me paid by E. L. Martin and Jennie H. Martin
do hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said
E. L. Martin and Jennie H. Martin and unto their heirs and
assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
the City and County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The south fifty feet of Lot 41, in Block 146, in the City
of Tulsa, according to the Government plat and survey
thereof and more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at the southwest corner of said Block 146,
running thence in a northerly direction parallel with
Cincinnati Avenue 50 feet, thence in an easterly
direction parallel with south line of South Fifth
Street, 140 feet, thence in a southerly direction
parallel with Detroit Avenue, 50 feet to the north
line of South Sixth Street, thence in a westerly
direction parallel with north line of South Sixth
Street, 140 feet to place of beginning.

This deed being to release the lien of a certain deed
of mortgage dated November 15th, 1907, and recorded
November 19th, 1907 in Book 30 at page 6 of the records
of the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, by E. L. Martin and Jennie
H. Martin conveying said real estate to D. F.
Colley to secure payment of two certain notes therein
named, the same having been fully paid.
