 under the act of congress approved May 31, 1900 (31 Stat.,
 121) and acting under authority of the act of Congress
 approved July 1, 1902 (32 Stat., 716), ratified by the
 Cherokee Nation August 4, 1902 has appraised the
 lots in the town of North Tulsa Cherokee Nation,
 Indian Territory; and
