

The real estate described hereunder to Frank W. Biel who has paid One hundred and sixty (\$160.) dollars, the full amount of the purchase price, into the Treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Cherokee Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian agent at Nowogee, Indian Territory, and is, therefore, entitled to a patent. Now, therefore, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the special act of the Congress of the United States, hereby grant all and convey unto the said Frank W. Biel Five acres and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Cherokee Nation, as aforesaid, in and to the lot numbered 6, and, in block numbered South 6 of lot 7 in Block 15 in the township North 7 T. 2 E., Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, and according to the plat thereon file as aforesaid. In witness whereof, I, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the great seal of said nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown.
