Guardian's Deed.

This Indenture made this 29th day of May 1908 by and between Aaron Tynan, the duly appointed, qualified and acting guardian of the estate of Lemuel E. Leahy, a minor, party of the first part, and James H. Welling, party of the second part witnesses:-

That whereas on the 25th day of March, 1907 the County Court within and for this county of Tulsa State of Oklahoma made an order of sale and trying the said party of the first part to sell, contain real estate of the said minor, the said Lemuel E. Leahy, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma and specified and particularly described in said order of sale either in one parcel or subdivisions, as the said party of the first part should judge most beneficial to the said estate, and which said order of sale now on file and of record in said County Court is fully signed
