Circuit of Confirmation

On appearing to the Court at a hearing on the 6th day of June, 1915, that on the 23rd day of May, 1915, Circuit J. W. Campbell executed, in the above entitled cause, filed her petition in this court praying for the confirmation of the sale of the land herein described, and, she further appearing to the Court that on the said 23rd day of May, 1915, the Court made an order setting the 6th day of June, 1915 for the hearing of said petition, and in said order required the production of the will of said decedent for a point of the sale previous to the said 6th day of June, 1915 and, at further appearing to the Court that under the above order of the above named decedent, the said will of the said decedent was produced, the said will having been admitted to probate in this court on the 10th day of December, 1917, the said Circuit J. W. Campbell, the petitioner herein, was authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all of the real estate of said decedent as to her owned, joint and proper, and,

At further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said will, the said Circuit J. W. Campbell, with her B. W. Singleton as her (S) in Book must (1) of the County of Oklahoma addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, George O. Ruggman addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the sum of \$1000.00, and, at further appearing to the Court that no objection of said was required of said will of the said decedent and that said sale was legally made and fully conducted, that the same said was more than 1/3 of the approved value of said B. W.
