 Whereas, the Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an  
 oil and gas mining lease, dated March 13, 1905, entered into by  
 and between Big Indian Oil and Gas Company, a corporation  
 of Collinsville, Oklahoma, lessor, and Charles Harris of Muskogee,
