

Party Wall Contract.

Know all men By These Presents:

That J. A. Z. Bouwell in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Twenty and ⁶⁶/₁₀₀ (\$320.66) Dollars to me in hand paid by P. E. Coyne, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, do hereby sell, assign, set over and convey to said P. E. Coyne, his successors or assigns an undivided one half interest in and to the Party wall erected and centering on the line between Lots fourteen and fifteen in Block eighty nine in Tulsa, Oklahoma, said wall facing on Main Street, having a depth of forty one feet, a height of three stories and a uniform thickness of eighteen inches, said wall to be and remain a Party Wall as between the owners of such respective lots, forever, and with all the privileges and covenants incident to Party Walls.
