

Release of mortgage.
 Whereas on the 15th day of October A.D. 1904 W.E. W. Harwood
 and Anna W. Harwood his wife by their certain mortgage
 recorded in the office of the recorder of deeds at Tulsa, Okla.
 in record number 20 page 409. in the office of the
 Deputy United States Marshal and Ex-officio Recorder,
 conveyed to the Dickman Lumber Company, a corporation, real estate as follows:

 Company a corporation; do hereby release
 and quit claim above described real estate and
 every part thereof to said W.E. W. Harwood and
 Anna W. Harwood his wife and their heirs and
 assigns forever, and do hereby certify, discharge
 and cancel said mortgage and the lien and effect
