Know all men by these presents, that we, N. L. Larkin, of Tucker Oklahoma, and N. L. Crowe of Tucker Oklahoma, for and in consideration of \$100, good and lawful money of the United States, to us in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by the present deed sell, assign, transfer and set over in unto, Archibald Campbell of Tucker Oklahoma, a certain indenture of lease for oil and gas purposes, on the following described land, to wit: S. 8 of the N. 34 of the NW 4, and S. 2 of the NW 4 of the NW 4, in section 17, township 20, north range 13 east, containing forty acres more or less, said lease being executed by H. T. Jones Martha Allen Jones, both of Tucker Oklahoma, and bearing date of June 5th 1908, with all and singular the premises therein mentioned, together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and to hold, the same unto the said Archibald Campbell, his heirs and assigns, executors and administrators, from the 12th day of June 1908, for and doing all the rest, set aforesaid and remainder of the term of the said indenture of lease, subject nevertheless to the covenants, conditions and provisions therein containing.
