

Release of Mortgage.

As now all money by that secured, whereas, on the 20th day of March, 1905, a certain mortgage was executed by G. H. Part of Lots 4 and 5 in Block 105 of the City of Tucker, Oklahoma, described as follows:

Beginning at the southeasterly corner of said lots in Block 105, and thence in a northerly direction along the easterly line of main street a distance of 17 feet thence in an easterly direction and parallel with the southeasterly line of said lots a distance of 14 feet more or less to the very line, thence in a southeasterly direction along the alley line a distance of 20 1/2 feet, thence in a westerly direction and parallel with the westerly line through a distance of 140 feet, more or less, to main street, thence in a northerly direction along the easterly line of main street 3 1/2 feet to place of beginning.
