

of the nation and that any such assignment or transfer made or attempted without such consent and approval shall be void.

The covenants herein contained shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors and administrators successively assigned the parties to this case, and this lease shall be subject to all rules and regulations lawfully prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior or which may be hereafter prescribed by him.

Receipt of the second part hereby acknowledged by him, and the first made and executed by the parties to the second part as principals and = N.E. Ellingwood as agent - dated at the day of - and filed above remain on file in the Indian Office.

It is expressly understood and agreed by the parties hereto that if the Secretary of the Interior is satisfied that any of the covenants contained herein, or that any of the provisions of any regulation heretofore, or that may hereafter be lawfully prescribed by him, have been or are being violated, he cannot be relieved without notifying to the court and without further proceedings and that the court shall then be entitled to take such action as it may deem proper of the land.
