Know all men by these presents that for and in consideration of One dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, A. M. Turner, do hereby transfer, assign and set over to Alice Fittell, all of my right, title and interest in and to the east half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the south west 10th (10) acres of lot three (3) in section three (3), township 19 north, Range 12 east, situate in the Creek Water, Western District of the Indian Territory and containing five acre more or less To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said Alice Fittell, her heirs and assigns forever. This assignment and transfer is made by reason of the interest held by me under and virtue of the rental contract and lease given December 14, 1905 by Edwin Keltner and Willie Keltner his wife to G. B. Brown for a period of three years from the 1st day of January, 1906, subsequently sold and assigned to Charles E. Beyl by the said G. B. Brown both of whom have in turn made assignments to the said A. M. Turner. This assignment and transfer is made and executed on the 10th day of July, 1907.
