formerly the Indian Territory, now called Tulsa
County, in the State of Oklahoma.
The consideration of said assignment is hereby
acknowledged received, and I authorize said sum
of money being order paid to the said attorneys as
soon as the suit now pending at Tulsa is determined,
with my acknowledgment of the parties litigant or by
