

Deed of Release

Know all Men By these Presents:

That the Farmers National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, formerly (D.P.) by J. V. Smith Vice Cashier for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to it paid by William Neel, who is one and the same person as William J. Neel, does hereby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said William Neel and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of Lot 7 in Block 20, in the North Tulsa Addition except the North 12 feet of said lot.

Also that portion of Lot 3 in Block 6 in Tulsa described as follows: Beginning at the North west corner of said Lot 3, running thence South 13 feet along Boston Avenue, thence East thirty one feet to the line dividing the Creek and Cherokee Nations, thence West along said line to the place of beginning.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage, dated January 7th 1907 and recorded January 17th 1907, in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court, at Tulsa (S.D.) and recorded in Book 3 at Page 136, by William Neel and Mary Neel his wife, conveying said real estate to Farmers National Bank, to secure the payment of one certain promissory note, therein specified in amount \$172.80, the same having been fully paid.
