

Release of mortgage -
 Show all - men by three present, that J. John T. Lay,
 in consideration of value received, do hereby
 acknowledge full payment - and complete satisfaction
 of a certain mortgage given by Mary W. Wagon and
 P. J. Wagon, her husband, to John T. Lay, for the sum of
 nine hundred dollars with interest four dollars at
 the rate of eight per cent per annum, dated the
 first day of March 1907, and filed for record the 28th
 day of February, 1907, book three (3) - page one hundred and
 eighty-four (184), in the office of the United States District
 Clerk of the 28th Recording District, of the Western District
 Indian Territory, the same now being found in
 the office of Registrar of Deeds of Tulsa County, State of
 Oklahoma. The property hereby released and
 discharged from said mortgage being as follows:
 sec 7 Lot 2 (4) Block eight (8) in the town of
 Tulsa, E. 1/4 Section, Eastern District, Indian Territory,
 the same is now divided into four (4) 1/4 sections
 (15), town of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma as said mortgage
 being given to secure a note of nine hundred dollars
 dated the first day of March 1907, bearing interest
 at the rate of eight per cent per annum; and
 signed by Mary W. Wagon and P. J. Wagon her husband.
 The sum of nine hundred and no cents
 dollar being paid to me in hand by the B. B.
 Robinson Lumber Company, receipts of which is hereby
 acknowledged and said mortgage and note
 being paid in full, J. John T. Lay hereby release
 and quit claim unto the said B. B. Robinson
 Lumber Company all say right to the said interest
 in said land described above. Witness my
