Know all men by these presents That A. W. T. Allen for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, to me paid by J. H. Boyd & family - grant, sell, quitclaim and deliver unto the said J. H. Boyd and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The east fifty (50) feet of Lot three (3) Block eighty six (86), according to the official plat and government survey of Tula Oklahoma. This deed being to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated January 13th 1905 and recorded January 15th 1905 in book 23 at page 570 of the records of the office of Register of Deeds of Tula, Tula County, Oklahoma conveying said real estate to W.
