

assignment of lease

Know all men by these presents that we William S. Guthrie and Weston Atwood both of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma Territory, and Robert Galbreath of Red Fork Indian Territory for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations to us paid by Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company of Tulsa Indian Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant bargain sell assign transfer and convey unto the said Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company of Tulsa Indian Territory, its successors and assigns, all of our right title and interest in and to the following described tract of land to-wit:-

North west quarter of southeast quarter of section 10 township 17 north Range 12 east of the Indian Meridian containing 40 acres more or less; together with the leasehold estate interests and rights accruing to us under and by virtue of that certain oil and gas mining lease executed by Ida C. Glenn of Sapulpa Indian Territory, to said William S. Guthrie Weston Atwood and Robert Galbreath, dated April 22-1904 and expiring April 21-1919.

To Have and To Hold the said Lease, leasehold estate and interests and rights thereby granted in and to said property unto the said Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company, its successors and assigns subject however to all and singular the terms and conditions of said original lease.
