

Assignment

Known all men by these Presents that we William S. Guthrie and Milton Atwood, both of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma Territory and Robert Galbreath of Red Fork Indian Territory for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations to us paid by Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company of Tulsa Indian Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and convey unto the said Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company of Tulsa Indian Territory its successors and assigns all of our right-title and interest in and to the following, described lease and the leased estate interests and rights thereby granted and the appurtenances therunto belonging to wit: That certain lease executed by Elizabeth A. Crosby of Osage Indian Territory to said William S. Guthrie, Milton Atwood and Robert Galbreath by instrument of lease dated April 19th 1904 and expiring April 18-1919, which lease leases for oil and gas mining purposes the following tract of land situate in the Creek nation of the Indian Territory to wit: the south west quarter of Section 2, Township 17 north Range 22 east of the Indian Meridian containing 160 acres more or less. To have and to hold the said lease, leasehold estate and interests and rights hereby granted in and to said property unto the said Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company its successors and assigns subject however to all and singular the terms and conditions of said original lease.
