This Indenture made and entered into this 24th day of November 1906 by the Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company, witnesseth that whereas, the Honorable Secretary of the Interior on November 2-1906, granted authority to Messrs. William S. Guthrie, Weston Atwood, and Robert Galbreath lessees of a certain oil and gas mining lease executed by Elizabeth A. Crossby dated April 19 1904 expiring April 18-1919 and covering the south west quarter of Section 2, Township 17, north Range 12 east containing 160 acres in the Creek nation of the Indian Territory to transfer said lease to the Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company and whereas the said lessees have this day executed a formal assignment of all their right title and interest in the said lease to the said Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company and it is desired that the said Company formally accept the said lease and the obligations thereunder

Now therefore know all men by these Presents that the Galbreath-Colcord Oil Company doth accept the said lease and the assignment thereof and doth by these presents bind itself to full and faithful performance of all the obligations of the said lease to the same extent and in the same manner as the said original lessees were bound
