 State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) Block Eight (8) in the Amended Plat of SubDivision  
 of Blocks Two (2) Three (3) and Seven (7) of Terrace Drive  
 Addition to the city of Tulsa, Okla. according to the recorded  
 plat thereof.

 used a homestead by me. )
