Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part y of the first part do, GS by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part y  
of the second part his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma.  
to-wit:

A lot or partial of land Fifty Feet (50') by One Hundred and fifty feet  
(150') running East and West described as follows: to-wit: Beginning at the  
Northeast (NE) corner of Lot No Sixty Two (62) thence running West along the

North line of said lot a distance of One Hundred and fifty feet (150') thence running  
south a distance of fifty (50') thence running east a distance of One Hundred and  
Fifty (150') thence running North along the East line of said Lot No. Sixty two  
(62) a distance of fifty feet (150') to the point of beginning all in Block "E"

presents that he lawfully seized in his  
own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with  
the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judg-  
ments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.  
Oil gas and mineral rights are hereby reserved unto the party of the first part and same  
shall have the right to enter upon, operate and remove the same also subject to taxes.

and that he will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part y of the second part his heirs and assigns  
against said part y of the first part his heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or  
to claim the same.
