WITNESSETH, That said part V of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 DOLLARS to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do SS hereby quit-claim, grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said part V of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all his right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots nineteen (19) and Twenty (20) in Block thirty-five in West Tulsa, now an addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof.

Grantor hereby represents and states that said property has never been or intended to be his homestead under the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances there unto belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said part V of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
