 of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all their right, title,
 interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of Lots Fifteen (15) and Sixteen (16), Block Five
 (5), Overlook Park Addition to the city of Tulsa,
 according to the recorded plat thereof.

This Deed is given to correct a General Warranty Deed

 Deed reads Overlook Addition, when it should read Overlook
