WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration - - - - - DOLLARS to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said part Y of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all their right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
