 to us duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said part Y  
 of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all our right, title,  
 interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa  
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Numbered Three (3) in Block Numbered Three (3),  
 in Oakdale Suburb, otherwise known as Oakdale  
 Addition to the city of Tulsa, according to the recorded  
 plat thereof,

 County, State of Oklahoma, on the 18th day of September,  
 1919, in the matter of hearing petition to sell said real
