to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties  
of the second part, and to its successors and assigns forever, all right, title,  
interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa  
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast  
Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-  
seven (27) lying South of the Frisco Railroad right  
of way; also that part of the Northeast Quarter of  
the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of  
said Section (27) lying and being South of Frisco  
right of way; also the South half of the Northeast  
Quarter of the Northwest Quarter; also that part of  
the South Half of the Northwest Quarter of the  
Northwest Quarter, lying South of the Frisco right  
of way; also the North Half of the Southwest Quarter
