THIS INDENTURE, Made this 26th day of April A. D. 1926 between M. W. Thompson of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and T. R. Lytle party of the second part

WITNESSETH, That said part Y. of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One & No/100 -- -- -- DOLLARS to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do es hereby quit-claim, grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said part Y. of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all his right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of the north half of the Southwest quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2), Township Eighteen (18) North. Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; it being the intent and purpose of this instrument to re-convey to said Lytle all oil and gas rights on in and under said land heretofore conveyed by said Lytle to said Thompson, but without disturbing any valid and subsisting oil and gas leases thereon.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances there unto belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said part Y. of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
