One note for \$600.00 due 30 months from date
 One note for \$500.00 due 55 months from date
 One note for \$500.00 due 80 months from date.

with interest at the rate of 8 per centum per annum, payable monthly on the principal sum

And the first part 1st agree to keep the buildings insured for \$ 2500.00

In case that the papers for foreclosure are filed, the first part 1st agree to pay an attorney fee of \$ 50.00

Now, if said part 1st of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part 1st of the second part their heirs or as-
 signs, said sum of money in the above described note together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall
 be wholly discharged and void, and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof or any interest thereon, is
 not paid when the same is due, or if the taxes or assessments levied against said premises or any part thereof, or the taxes assessed against the said second party or
