FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of Eleven 50/100 Dollars, to the undersigned owners paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned hereby grant to THE PRAIRIE PIPE LINE COMPANY, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kansas, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas, together with the right of ingress and egress, on, over and through the following described lands situate in Tulsa County and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

In the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, Township 18 North,
Rajge 12 East.

The said undersigned owners, their heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except as the same may be necessary for the purposes herein granted to the said THE PRAIRIE PIPE LINE COMPANY, its successors or assigns..
