

Beginning at a point on the North line of Lot 4, Block 9, Norvell Park Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, 40 feet West of the Northeast corner of said lot; thence Southwesterly to a point on the South line of said Lot, 32 feet West of the Southeast corner of said lot.

for the purpose of permitting the City of Tulsa to construct a sewer line thereto, through, over, under and across said property, together with all necessary and convenient appurtenances thereto; and to use and maintain the same, and of affording the City of Tulsa, its officers, agents, employees, and all persons under contract with it, the right to enter upon said premises and strip of land for the purpose of surveying, excavating for, laying, constructing, operating, repairing, relaying and maintaining said sewer line and for the further purpose of enabling the City of Tulsa, to do any and all necessary and convenient things, incident to such construction, operation, repairing, and maintaining of such sewer line.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD such easement and right of way unto the City of Tulsa, its successors or assigns, forever.

ORDINANCE NO. 2339

An Ordinance vacating Sixteenth street, between Lot 5 in Block 2, and Lot 1, in Block 3, between Fifteenth and Seven tenth streets in Liberty Place (Maywood Addition) as shown in recorded Plat of Liberty Place (Maywood Addition) City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, with certain reservations and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by all of the property owners owning property abutting on the street in the lots and blocks herein mentioned has been presented to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, asking that the street therein described be vacated and abandoned as a public street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That the street running East and West between Lot Five in Block Two
