benefits of the homestead and stay laws of said State.

NinthL-It is further agreed that in event any of the land herein described is sought to be taken by virtue of the law of eminent domain or under the provision of Chapter 46 of Volume 37, Statutes at Large of the United States, approved February 19, 1912, the said mortragor, his administrators, executors, successors, will promptly notify the mortgagee or its acsigns of the institution of proceedings in eminent domain or any attempt to purchase or appropriate the surface of said property under said Chapter 46, Statutes, at Large, Volume 37, and agrees and directs that all condemnation or puchase money which may be agreed upon or which may be found to be due, be paid to the party of the second part or its assigns and be credited upon the balance due hereunder.

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Tenth:-As additional and collateral security for the payment of the note and the indebtedness hereinbefore described, said mortgagor hereby assigns to said mortgagee its successors and assigns, all of the profits, revenues, royalties, rights and renefits accruing under all oil, gas or mineral leases now on said property, or which may hereafter be placed thereon, and the lessee or assignee or sub-lessee is hereby directed on production of this mortgage or certified copy thereof, to pay said profits, revenues royalties, rights and benefits to the said mortgagee, its successors and assigns; this provision to become effective only upon default in the terms and conditions of this mortgage or the note hereby secured, or, prior to such default, upon notice to the lessee in such oil, gas or mineral lease, and to terminate and become null and void $^{\mathrm{O}}$ upon release of this mortgage.

Eleventh:-In construing this mortgage, the word "mortgagor" wherever used shall be held to mean the persons named in the preamble as parties of the first part. jointly and severally.

The foregoing covenants and conditions being kept and performed, this conveyance shall be void; otherwise to remain of full force and virtue.

Upon satisfaction of this mortrage the mortragor agrees to accept from the mortgagee a duly executed release of same, have it recorded and pey the cost of recording.
