KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That EXCHANGE TRUST COMPANY, a corporation having its place of business in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, as Trustee, in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration to it in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto J. A. Wood of Turley, Tulsa County, Okla. as party of the second part (whether one or more), the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot One (1) in Block Three (3)

in North Turley Addition to the town of Turley, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, together with all improvements thereon and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, except as hereinafter set forth.

Said Trustee on behalf of those owning the beneficial interest in said real estate at the time of the execution of this deed, as is shown in a certain Deed of Trust now of record in the office of the County Clerk, Ex-Officio Register of Deeds, of said County and State, dated the 29th day of April, 1920, but not on behalf of itself, covenants and agrees with the party of the second part that said Trustee at the time of the delivery of these presents is seized of a good and indefeasible title and estate of inheritance in fee simple in and to said real estate and covenants that it is in peaceful and undisputed possession of said premises, with full right and power to convey the same
