KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, R. E. Thompson and Olivia Mercier Thompson,  
his wife, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, parties of  
the first part, have mortgaged and hereby mort-  
gage to Elton Everett, party of the second part,

the following described real estate and premises situated in Tulsa County, State of  
Oklahoma, to-wit: Lot Numbered Seventeen (17), Block Two (2), Weaver Addition, to the  
City of Tulsa, according to the recorded plat thereof, subject, however, to a first  
mortgage made payable to The Exchange Trust Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, in the sum of  
Three Thousand Dollars, with all improvements thereon and appurtenances thereto belong-  
ing, and warrant the title to the same.

This mortgage is given to secure the principal sum of Twenty-seven Hundred
