per cent per annum, provided that such payments by the mortgage and draw interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum, provided that such payments by the mortgage shall not operate as a waiver of the right to foreclose the mortgage under the provisions of the fourth special covenant hereinbefore set out.

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SIXTH.
