O R D E R

NOW on this 10th day of October, 1922, this matter coming on for hearing upon the petition of Larry Brown and Hardin Brown, petitioners in the above styled cause, praying for an order of court approving a certain deed of conveyance executed by them as the sole and only heirs of Sherman Brown, deceased, covering lands hereinafter described, and the said petitioners appearing in person and by the Honorable Peter Reichman, United States Probate Attorney, and the SAND SPRINGS HOME being present by its attorneys, Stuart, Cruce & Bland, and the Court after hearing the testimony of various witnesses in support of the petition and as to the value of the real estate and premises conveyed, and being fully advised in the premises, finds that the allegations contained in said petition are true; that Larry Brown is a full blood Creek Indian, enrolled opposite No. 1983; that Hardin Brown is a full blood Creek Indian, enrolled opposite No. 1984; that one Sherman Brown, deceased, was a minor full blooded Creek Indian, enrolled opposite No. 116, and that there was allotted to the said Sherman Brown as his distributive share of the lands of the Creek Nation the following described lands situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
