RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

WHEREAS, J. F. O'Donnell and Edith Gertrude O'Donnell, his wife, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, did under date of October 15th 1919, execute a certain real estate mortgage recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on October 25th, 1919, in Book 290, page 111, to R. NOW WHEREFORE, the said Exchange Trust Company, said assignee, the present owner and holder of said mortgage and the note thereby secured, does hereby acknowledge full satisfaction of all obligations mentioned in said mortgage and in said note and does hereby remise, release and forever quit claim all its right, title and interest in and to said real estate unto the said J. F. O'Donnell and Edith Gertrude O'Donnell, his wife, their heirs, and assigns, forever.
