of the parties of the second part.

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It is further agreed; that at the expiration of this lease or sooner termination thereof the second parties shall give peaceful possession of the premises to first parties in as good condition as they now are, the usual wear and tear and damage of the elements alone expected, and upon the non-payment of rent or any part thereof, at the day and date set forth in this contract, first parties may distrain for rent due and declare this lease at an end and void and re-enter and take possession thereof or bring action for possession by forcible entry and detainer. This lease shall not be considered renewed except by the written agreement of the parties.

It is further stipulated and agreed that time shall be the essence of this contract.

It is further agreed between the parties hereto that said second parties shall conduct said place of business on the above described premises in a lawful manner and shall not themselves violate the law in the occupancy of said premises nor permit any one else to do so. That they shall not sell or permit to be sold or have upon said premises, any intoxicating liquors, or any intoxicates of whatsoever kind or nature, nor shall they permit gambling upon said premises, now shall they permit a body house to be conducted therein nor shall second parties permit any other act or things to be done upon said premises which shall be a violation of the Ordinances of the City of <sup>T</sup>ulsa, or the Statutory Laws of the State of Oklahoma.

The covenants and agreements contained in this Lease shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors and assigns of the parties hereto.
