KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, Whereas, on the 18 day of March, 1922, in the District Court in and for Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, at the March term of said Court, in a certain action therein pending, wherein Robert W. Armstrong, was plaintiff and Bertha McCright, Bertha McCright administratrix, Ben McCright, Ruth McCright et al were defendants, the said plaintiff Robert W. Armstrong by the consideration of the Court, recovered a judgment against the said defendants for foreclosure of a mortgage upon the following described lands and tenements of said defendants to-wit:
