WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other considerations DOLLARS to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest, estate -----claim and demand both at law and equity in and to all the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point Fifty-Five (55) feet West of the Northeast corner of Block Seventeen (17) of Gillette Hall Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, thence West Forty Three (43) feet thence South One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet, thence East Forty Three (43) feet thence North One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet, to point of beginning, said property being situated in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
