BILL OF SALE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That whereas, heretofore, to-wit: On the 14th day of May, 1921, the court entered a decree in the above entitled cause in favor of the plaintiff, Oil Well Supply Company, and against the defendant, Jontell Gasoline Company, adjudging it to have a mechanic's lien upon the following described property in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

A lease on a tract of land 300 feet square in the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.

together with one Unit casing-head gasoline plant complete, situated on the above described real estate; one office building, 10 feet by 30 feet; one compressor building, 20 feet by 50 feet, containing one Twin Ingersoll Compressor; one engine house, 20 feet by 50 feet, containing one Miller gas engine, 120 horse power; one building, 30 by 40 feet, containing one Miller vacuum engine, 80 horse power; two 4-room dwelling houses; four steel storage tanks, 8000 gallons each; one 1600-barrel water tank; one warehouse, 20 feet by 30 feet; 10,000 feet of 4-inch line pipe; 15,000 feet of 2-inch line pipe; one set of cooling coils; together with all other appurtenances and equipment necessary or used for an in connection with the operation of the said gasoline plant located upon the above described real estate; and

whereas, there was also rendered in the above entitled cause on the said 14th day of May, 1921, a judgment foreclosing mortgage in favor of the defendant, First National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and against the said defendant, Jontell Gasoline Company; and whereas, in pursuance of the said decree of the said court there was issued in said cause on the 27th day of May 1921, directed to the Sheriff of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and commanding him to advertise and sell the leasehold interest of the Jontell Gasoline Company upon the above described premises together with the said casing-head gasoline plant and
